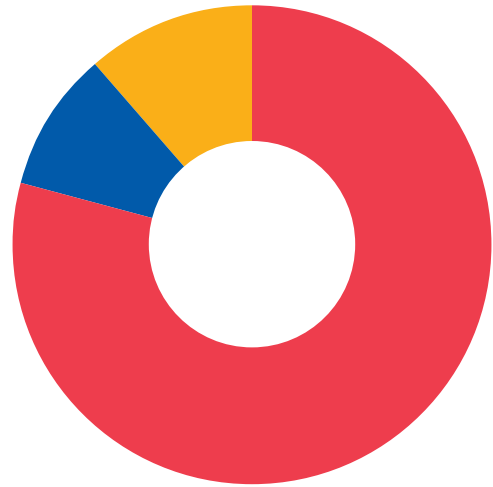
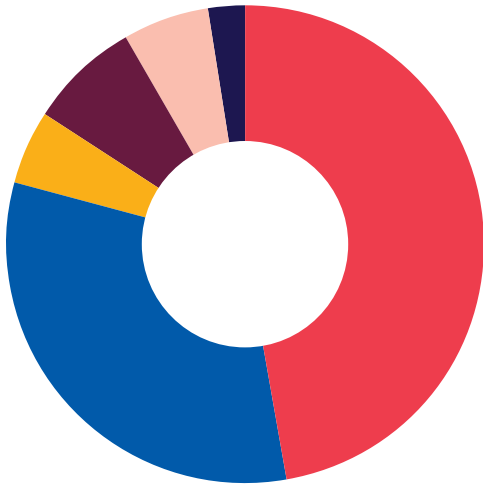


Financial Summary + Deep Gratitude
