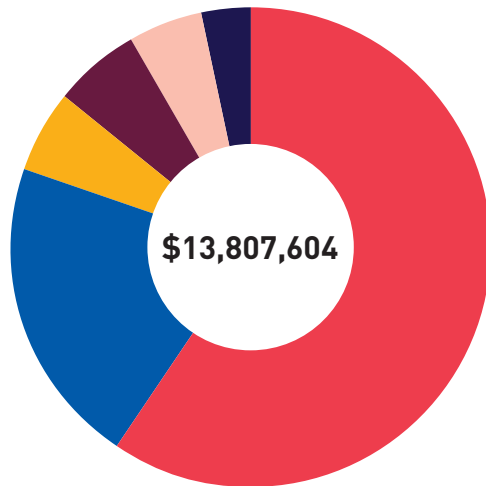


# Financial Summary

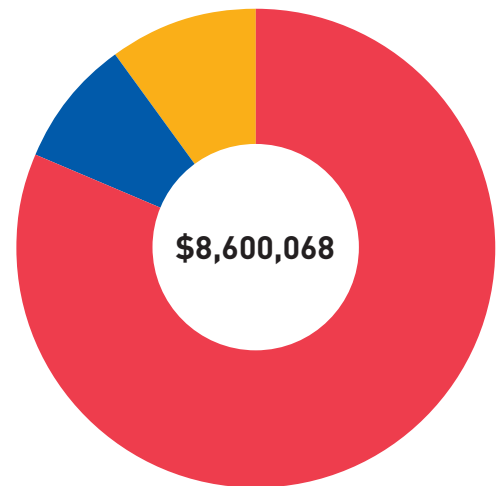
