This matter came before the court on the petitioners' amended petition for relief under

G. L. 211, § 3, and for declaratory relief under G. L. c. 231A, § 1. Upon consideration, it is ORDERED that the amended petition is denied without prejudice to refiling in the Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County. The subsequent filing shall take the form of a civil pleading, not an appellate brief, with numbered factual allegations and discrete causes of action and prayers for relief that can be answered in due course by the named respondents. After filing, the respondents within 15 days shall file an answer, which shall indicate all material factual allegations that they dispute. Along with its pleading, each side may file a supporting

memorandum of law not to exceed twenty double-spaced pages. The single justice will then
