





Your Location: It's None of Their Business


Only one-in-three voters know companies can sell their location data.





Almost all voters find the collection and sales of cellphone location data concerning.










Massachusetts is considering a new law prohibiting the sale of location data. Would you support or oppose passing a state law to prohibit companies from selling your location data?




There is high, bipartisan support for a law to prohibit the sale of location data.















Voters are extremely concerned about potential abuses of location data



By a 3-to-1 margin, voters think the state — not individual cell phone users — has a responsibility to protect location data privacy.
