 - A. Sometimes, but not generally.
- Q. And are there any other officers besides
 CAP officers who might be involved in learning the
 date of release for an A through D individual?
- A. Not in learning the date, but -- well, I shouldn't say that. The 287(g) officers and the ICE officers who oversee the 287(g) program, they would handle the 287(g) facilities, but otherwise, generally speaking, the CAP officers that are in the facilities.
