

RE: SWAT Callout Newbury

On Thursday November 14, 2013 at approximately 1530 hours the NEMLEC SWAT Team was activated to assist the Newbury Police Department with serving a high risk arrest warrant. The team was instructed to stage at [REDACTED] Kent Way Newbury. Upon my arrival at the staging area I was briefed on the situation by Deputy Chief Lucy of the Newbury Police Department and Lt. Chaput. The Newbury Police Department had received a report of past domestic incident (incident occurred on 11/13/2013) in which the victim reported that her ex-husband [REDACTED] had choked her unconscious and had also fired multiple rounds from a handgun before fleeing the scene of the attack. As a result of this report the Newbury Police Department had applied for and obtained an arrest warrant, docket # 1322CR002661 out of Newburyport District Court for Attempted Murder for [REDACTED]. During the course of the investigation it was also learned that [REDACTED] had been recently fired from his job at a clam processing center in Newbury as a result of some erratic behavior and threatening statements made towards the owner of the business. [REDACTED] had reportedly made arrangements with the owner to pick up his last pay check at 1800 hours at the processing center. The clam processing center is located in a secluded area of Newbury at [REDACTED] Grove Street and was closed for the day.

The operational plan called for putting a team (Alpha) in place at the processing center and taking [REDACTED] into custody when he arrived to pick up his check. Two support teams (Bravo and Delta) would be put in place in a nearby cul-de-sac for support if needed. It was unknown what type of vehicle [REDACTED] would be operating. After briefing the teams on the situation and on the operational plan the teams were put into place at approximately 1715 hours. The Alpha team was dropped off at the Grove Street location and made contact with owner of the business and the three Newbury PD officers that were already stationed at the address. The plan was briefed with owner of the business and the Newbury PD personnel on scene. At approximately 1730 hours the [REDACTED] contacted the owner of the business and indicated that he would be arriving in approximately 30 minutes.

At approximately 1800 hours a vehicle (Texas reg [REDACTED] 2011 Mazda) arrived at the location. There were three people inside the vehicle. [REDACTED] was identified as the rear passenger. Once it was obvious to the Alpha Team that [REDACTED] was not going to exit the vehicle, the team

moved in and took [REDACTED] into custody without incident. [REDACTED] was removed from the vehicle and handcuffed by Sgt. Bourque and Operator Rego. The other two occupants (driver) [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], were removed from the vehicle and turned over to Newbury PD. A protective sweep of the passenger compartment of the vehicle was conducted by members of the Alpha team, no weapon was located.

After the scene was stabilized Rosen and the other two passengers were turned over to Newbury PD. The teams then returned to the staging area and debriefed the operation. The hours of the operation were 1530 – 1930 hours.
