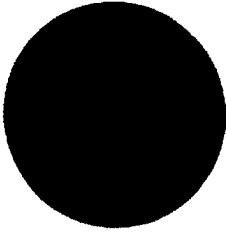

RE: SWAT Callout Lowell Street Peabody

On Friday February 14, 2014 the NEMLEC SWAT Team was activated to assist the Peabody Police Department with serving a high risk search warrant. The team was instructed to stage at the Peabody Police Department 6 Allens Lane at 0430 hours. Upon my arrival at the staging area I met with Det. Eric Ricci of the Peabody Police Department who informed me that as a result of a narcotics investigation he had obtained a nighttime No-Knock search warrant out of Peabody District Court for [REDACTED] Lowell Street [REDACTED] floor. The main target of the investigation was [REDACTED] er [REDACTED] is involved in distributing Heroin and is believed to be in possession of a handgun. Det. Ricci also stated that a second suspect, [REDACTED] was also distributing cocaine and marijuana out of the apartment. According To Det. Ricci recent information indicated that a female was also staying in the apartment with her 10 year old son. According to Det. Ricci it is also not unusual for multiple guests to be staying at the apartment overnight. The target location is a multi-unit dwelling with a vacant restaurant on the first floor and a vacant apartment on the third floor.

After conducting a reconnaissance drive by of the target location with the team leaders and vehicle operators an operational plan was developed. The operational plan called for both the Alpha and the Bravo Teams to make entry on the one side and proceed to the second floor landing and conduct simultaneous breaches into the second floor apartment. The Alpha team would make entry into the main apartment and the Bravo Team would conduct a breach and hold on the apartment door leading into the suspect's bedroom. The Delta Team would secure the perimeter of the building. After giving individual team assignments several rehearsals were performed along with a brief back.

At approximately 0530 the teams loaded up into their assigned vehicles and proceeded to the target location over a predetermined route. The order of vehicles was Bravo, Alpha, Delta and command element. At approximately 0538 hours the teams arrived at the target location and dismounted and initiated the warrant service. Once in position the Alpha and Bravo Teams conducted simultaneous breaches of the second floor apartment doors. Upon entry the Alpha Team encountered the main suspect [REDACTED] on the couch watching TV. [REDACTED] was taken into custody by Operators DiChiara and Scotina. The Alpha Team continued into the apartment and located a male subject [REDACTED] in a bedroom. [REDACTED] was taken into custody by Sgt.

Gaultieri. The Bravo Team upon breaching the bedroom door was immediately confronted by a [REDACTED] and her 10 year old son [REDACTED]. Mother and son were detained in the bedroom by members of the Bravo team. The Delta Team was able to secure the perimeter of the location without incident.

After conducting a secondary search of the target location the suspects and apartment were turned over to members of the Peabody Police Department. The team then returned to the staging area and conducted a debrief of the operation. The hours of the operation were 0330 – 0730 hours.
