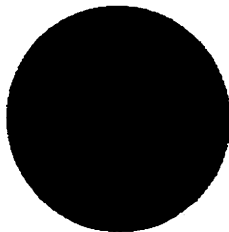

SUBJ: SWAT callout to assist Lowell P.D.

On April 03, 2013 the NEMLEC SWAT Team and K-9 Unit responded to a staging area at the [REDACTED] Old Ferry Road Lowell, Massachusetts for the search of armed suspects. Upon our arrival we learned the Lowell Police received a call for an armed home invasion located at [REDACTED] Freda Lane Lowell, Massachusetts. The Lowell Police learned two [REDACTED] males forced entry into the home armed with a handgun. The victim's [REDACTED] daughter heard voices and came out of her bedroom. She observed two [REDACTED] males next to her father. The two suspects looked at each other and stated "who are we going to shoot first". The daughter immediately fled into the bathroom and locked the door. She then jumped out the window and ran to a neighbor's house. The two suspects fled in an unknown direction by unknown means. The home is located in a secluded area surrounded by a large wooded state forest. The Lowell Police believe they may have fled in a motor vehicle but want to conduct a search of the wooded area for safety purposes.

At this time the NEMLEC K-9 units were conducting a search of the wooded area. The SWAT Team was placed on standby at the staging area pending the results of the K-9 Units findings. During the search of the area the K-9 Units were not successful in tracking the suspects. The Lowell Police were convinced the suspects fled in a motor vehicle and canceled the search. The SWAT Team cleared the scene and responded back to the scheduled training for the day. Further investigation by the Lowell Police revealed the incident was possibly over narcotics (Marijuana and cocaine). The victim was also bleeding from the head and a bullet hole was discovered inside the home.
