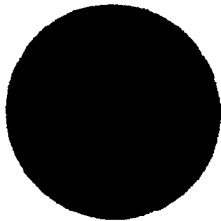

SUBJ: SWAT callout to Tyngsboro

On July 01, 2013 at 1200 hours the NEMLEC SWAT team was requested to stage at the Tyngsboro Police Department 20 Westford Road Tyngsboro, Massachusetts to assist with serving an active restraining order to a suspect who is believed to be armed with several long arms, handguns, and suppressors.

Upon our arrival we learned the suspect ( [REDACTED] ) has approx. 36 weapons and 4 suppressors registered to him which he purchased in New Hampshire. The most recent purchase was a Sig Sauer 1911 45 caliber handgun on April 23, 2013. The suspect has not lived in New Hampshire for the past three years and there is no record of him having a Massachusetts License to Carry. The Tyngsboro Police also received information he may be dealing steroids and is living with his current girlfriend ( [REDACTED] ) located at [REDACTED] Merrimack Way apartment [REDACTED] Tyngsboro, Massachusetts. The suspect is operating a 2009 Honda Accord, color silver bearing a New Hampshire registration of 3210740. This vehicle is registered to the suspect with a New Hampshire address [REDACTED] Nancy Avenue Pelham, NH) belonging to his grandmother. The grandmother had recently signed an affidavit stating the suspect has not lived there in three years.

The suspect has been involved in incidents with police in the past and has currently filed a law suit against the Lowell Police Department. The ex-wife [REDACTED] filed the restraining order (Docket No. 1311RO942) against the suspect which states for him to stay away from their children and her residence located at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Dracut, Massachusetts. During the briefing the Tyngsboro Police had been conducting surveillance on the suspect to include following him into New Hampshire. The Tyngsboro Police requested the SWAT Team to be in close proximity while they conduct a motor vehicle stop in front of his residence in Tyngsboro. During the planning stages of the mission the Tyngsboro Police had lost the surveillance on the suspect at a Walgreens in New Hampshire. The suspect was unable to be located and information was received that he picks up the kids at [REDACTED] Dracut, Massachusetts at 1500 hours every day.

Due to losing contact with the suspect several operators responded to [REDACTED] Road Dracut, Massachusetts while the remainder of the operators stood by at [REDACTED] Merrimack Way Tyngsboro, Massachusetts. While in position a Dracut Police officer locates the suspect vehicle (NH Registration [REDACTED]) pull into [REDACTED] em Road and conducts a motor vehicle stop. The suspect is advised about the restraining order and is requested to be escorted back to the Dracut Police Department for further questioning. The suspect was advised to respond back to the Dracut Police department due to the heavy rain and wind from a current Tornado watch. The suspect agrees and is interviewed by the Dracut and Tyngsboro Police. After the interview the Tyngsboro Police respond back to [REDACTED] Merrimack Way with the suspect for further investigation in locating the large list of firearms and suppressors. The NEMLEC SWAT Team conducted a debriefing and cleared the scene.
