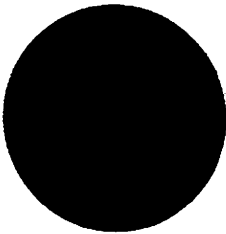

On Thursday August 1, 2013 the NEMLEC SWAT Team was activated to assist the Peabody Police Department with serving a high risk arrest warrant. The team was instructed to stage at the Peabody Police Department at 0500. Upon my arrival at the Peabody Police Department I met with Peabody Detectives Murphy and Ricci along with Agent Proulx of the DEA.

The investigators informed us that they had a federal arrest warrant out of the Boston district, case number [REDACTED] or [REDACTED]. The warrant was for manufacturing methamphetamine. [REDACTED] was involved in a manufacturing case approximately a year ago in the City of Peabody. [REDACTED] has a significant criminal history with arrests and convictions for narcotics, assault and battery with a dangerous weapon. [REDACTED] was also arrested in California after being involved in a drug related shooting.

[REDACTED] lives at [REDACTED] Lynn Street in Peabody with his girlfriend, [REDACTED] and her two small children. [REDACTED] Lynn Street is a single family cape style home. After conducting a reconnaissance drive by of the location with the team leaders and vehicle operators the following operational plan was developed. The team would be conducting a surround and callout, The Alpha Team would be the primary team deploying to the 1 side of the home and the Bravo Team would deploy to the 3/4 side of the home. The Delta Team would secure the perimeter of the home. Once all the teams were in place the negotiators would place a phone call into the suspect requesting him to come out. It should be noted that members of the DEA Clandestine Lab Team would also be present and providing support to the NEMLEC SWAT Team.

After conducting several rehearsals the teams traveled to a forward staging area at St. Ann's Church on Lynn Street. At approximately 0600 hours the teams moved out from the forward staging area to the target location. The order of vehicles was Alpha (Delta on the skids), Bravo, command vehicle, MSO Bear, and NEMLEC equipment truck. Once all the teams were in position negotiator Fogarty attempted to contact [REDACTED] by phone, this was met with negative results. It was at this time that negotiator Fogarty used the PA system on the Bearcat to request [REDACTED] to exit the home. Within several minutes [REDACTED] exited the front door and then was given verbal commands from members of the Alpha Team. [REDACTED] was taken into custody without incident and turned over to Peabody PD and DEA personnel. Once [REDACTED] was taken into custody his girlfriend, [REDACTED] exited the home, she was escorted to the DEA investigators where she gave consent to search the home. The Alpha and Bravo teams then conducted a protective sweep of the home.

The SWAT Team then cleared the scene and returned to the Peabody Police Department and conducted a de-brief of the operation. The team was then dismissed. The hours of the operation were 0400 - 0800.
