2012-2013 OMS and SHS Pilots

Moving forward with the district strategic priority of all 5-12 students in a 1:1 environment by 2016

During the 2012-2013 school year, the district will be implementing additional personal device pilots at both Oak Middle School and Shrewsbury High School. We will be applying what we have learned from the Sherwood pilot to these new pilot environments. This work will be done with the understanding that each environment is different, and adjustments will be needed to accommodate the unique characteristics of an individual school. Details of the scheduled pilots can be found below.

Oak Middle School

What is in currently in place?

- 1:1 Oak iPad Study Group consisting of Assistant Superintendent, Director of Technology, Curriculum Coordinators, Oak Administration, and 4 Oak teachers
- T21 Course for 2012-2013 school year
- Funding for one 7th grade pilot team (120 students), pilot team identified by 1st week in June
- Funding for one 8th grade pilot team (120 students), pilot team identified by 1st week in June
- 40 Oak teachers and administrators have iPads for exploration and initial orientation, all Oak faculty will have iPads prior to the start of the school year
- Collaboration day Oak and SHS pilot teams/Sherwood pilot team on 6/5/12
- Communication to parents prior to close of school year

Shrewsbury High School

What is currently in place?

- 9th grade pilot consisting of approximately 24 students who have the same schedule for ELA, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics
- 11th grade pilot with Humanities students and one section of honors discrete math taught by Math Department Chair
- All pilot teachers identified and have or will have an iPad by the end of the school year
- Student scheduling for these sections confirmed
- Collaboration day with Sherwood pilot team on 6/5/12
- Communication to parents prior to the close of the school year
