Is there financial aid for families who qualify for Free/Reduced lunch?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Yes. For families qualifying for reduced lunch the fee is reduced by 50% for a fee of \$82.50.</li> <li>• Yes. 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What about liability?	<p>An accident report will be completed by the school when damage occurs and if negligence is determined, the family will be responsible for full repair or replacement cost.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Damage that occurs while the device is out of its protective case will be treated as negligence.</li> </ul> <p>In school:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There will be no charge for the first repair of accidental damage that occurs at school and during school hours. The family is charged \$50 for a second repair, \$100 for a third repair, and full repair cost for any subsequent repair</li> <li>• Families will not be liable for an iPad lost or stolen at school during school hours provided that "Find my iPad" is turned on and used.</li> </ul> <p>Outside of school:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For accidental damages that occur outside of school, the first repair is \$50, the second repair is \$100, subsequent repairs are the full repair cost.</li> <li>• Families will be liable for the full replacement cost of an iPad lost or stolen outside of school.</li> <li>• Families may choose to purchase insurance if they are concerned about bearing the cost to repair or replace a district owned iPad</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Families are liable for the safekeeping of their iPad</li> <li>• Families may choose to purchase insurance if they are concerned about bearing the cost to repair or replace their iPad</li> <li>• District will be held harmless for damage or loss of family owned devices</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If purposeful damage, family is liable for repairing or replacing iPad</li> <li>• If accidental damage, district is liable for repairing or replacing iPad</li> </ul>
What about insurance?	<p>Private insurance is available at family expense. For example one vendor offers \$499 of coverage for a district device with a \$50 deductible for \$52/year.</p>	<p>Private insurance is available at family expense. For example one vendor offers \$499 of coverage for a family device with a \$50 deductible for \$37/year.</p>	N/A
