Recommendations

Move 1:1 Program to SHS

- All students in grades 9-12 to be in 1:1 environment starting next year (2015-16)
- iPad with keyboard recommended as personal device
 - Supports more transformative use of technology
 - * Access to apps unique to iOS (ie/Notability)
 - * Touch screen
 - Cost vs. laptop

Move to a District-Owned Device Model

- Eliminate current options and shift entirely to district owned
- Students receive new devices with cases in grade 5 and grade 9
- New app purchases will be district owned
- Reallocate resources and shift to a leasing model goal of budget neutral

Implications of Shift


- * Eliminate the "Personal Tech Fee" option families *currently* enrolled in this program will have a path to ownership if desired
- * Eliminate the "Bring Your Own" option all devices need to be district-owned to enroll in enhanced management software
- * Eliminate the "School Use Only" option all students will be able to bring their device back and forth from school to home

Adjust Liability Policy

Treat iPad like a textbook

Damaged, lost, or stolen textbook/iPad is family's responsibility

Will recommend 3rd party insurance to families




Learning Management System

Why is iPad the Best Fit for Shrewsbury?

- Shrewsbury IT staff to device ratio with iPads is 1:1100 PC recommendation is 1:400
- Shrewsbury is working with SAMR model and is looking to "redefine" learning Shrewsbury educators concluded that the iPad is more suited for innovation
- * Key apps in Shrewsbury's program are iOS only. (Notability, Explain Everything)
- Shrewsbury has been a Mac district for almost 25 years
- Shrewsbury will be providing robust keyboard case for high school students
- Almost all Shrewsbury students to have access to a computer or laptop at home
