5. On August 11, 2016, I received an email from Eneida Tavares, a Senior Data Analyst with the Boston Elections Department. Ms. Tavares wrote:


[The Boston Election Department's] records indicate that 2,308 voters registered between October 18<sup>th</sup> (the day following voter registration deadline) and the November 6, 2012 Presidential election. Additionally, another 4,403 registrations were received between February 11<sup>th</sup> (the day following voter registration deadline) and the March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 Presidential Primary Election. Please keep in mind that these numbers do not capture anyone who has since moved outside of Boston.
