Petitioners respectfully request to enter the following order:

- 1. Issue an injunction ordering Respondents not to detain, remove, or interrogate any individual solely on the basis of the Executive Order.
- 2. Adopt the decision of the Eastern District of New York in its entirety with an amendment to specifically include lawful permanent residents.
- 3. Enter a judgment declaring that Respondents' detention of Petitioners is and will be unauthorized by statutes and is contrary to laws of the United States.
 - 4. Award Petitioners reasonable costs and attorney's fees;

5. Direct Respondents order Customs and Border Protection to contact Airlines that have flights arriving at Logan Airport and inform them of this Court's order.

6. Grant any other and further relief that this Court may deem fit and proper.
