Dear Clerk Kenneally:

Amici the American Civil Liberties Union of Massachusetts, Inc., and the Massachusetts Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers submit this letter under Rule 16(1) of the Massachusetts Rules of Appellate Procedure to address comments made at oral argument on October 5, 2017, about the effect of pretextual traffic stops on public safety. Most significant, and most concerning, Justice Lowy stated that pretext stops "save lives."

Amici are unaware of any study finding, on net, that this is true. Pretextual traffic stops are often triggered by racial profiling or a preconceived suspicion about an unknown operator of a motor vehicle. Beyond the dignitary harms that routinely occur during pretextual traffic stops,<sup>1</sup> numerous lives have been extinguished, rather than saved, by apparently pretextual traffic stops. These include the lives of Sandra Bland, Philando Castile,

Samuel DuBose, and Walter Scott. A partial list of Black people killed during pretext stops has been enclosed with this letter.<sup>2</sup>

Indeed, on the very day that this case was argued, it was reported that police in Salt Lake City shot and killed an unarmed Black man named Patrick Harmon after stopping him for cycling without a light.<sup>3</sup>

Amici respectfully submit that, in assessing whether pretext stops actually save lives, these Black lives matter.
