STIPULATION CONCERNING WORCESTER COUNTY

Consistent with this Court's order of November 2, 2017, counsel for the District Attorney for Worcester County has conferred with counsel for the petitioners, and they have identified cases where there is agreement to vacate convictions and dismiss with prejudice. Specifically, the District Attorney for Worcester County and the petitioners agree to vacatur and dismissal with prejudice of all drug convictions in Worcester County involving alleged drug samples in which Sonja Farak signed the certificate of analysis. The District Attorney for Worcester County estimates that this will result in the dismissal of approximately 241 cases.

This stipulation is not conditioned on the relinquishment or cancellation of any other right, argument, or duty of the parties in this litigation. For example, petitioners enter into this stipulation without conceding the accuracy or completeness of any case list.
