Dear Clerk Doyle:

In response to the Court's First Interim Order, dated February 27, 2018, the District Attorneys have submitted "formatted interim lists" identifying adverse dispositions of Farak defendants that they agree should be vacated and dismissed with prejudice. To provide the Court and the parties with information about those submissions, and to facilitate the discussion at today's working group meeting, petitioners write to provide an *estimated* tally of the dispositions and cases identified in the District Attorneys' submissions.

As shown on the chart below, the District Attorneys have slated for vacatur and dismissal at least 9,417 adverse dispositions across 7,687 cases.
